

SAFETY WARNING!

The incorrect setup of your FLEX Insert Block may render the holster unsafe by allowing contact with the gun's trigger.

Before using your FLEX holster, make sure to watch the Setup tutorial video and fully understand the process.

Always test your setup thoroughly with an unloaded gun!

When testing, holster your **unloaded** gun cocked and unlocked (hammer back, safety disengaged) to ensure no contact is being made with the trigger. Of course, always engage the gun's safety when in actual use! This is a basic safety rule critical to all holsters.

Extra care must be taken with guns which have large, narrow, wire-frame trigger guards, such as the steel frame Tanfoglio and some CZ models. The triggers of these guns are often as wide as their trigger guards, and their narrow geometry make it easier to tilt them sideways while holstering.

Be sure to keep the side-to-side fit as narrow as possible to eliminate any chance of tilting the gun sideways while holstering, which could create unwanted contact with the trigger.

Ensuring correct and safe adjustment of your holster before use is your responsibility!

DO NOT attempt to use with a loaded gun until fully tested!
